TexVoIP Fleet Suite Fleet Tracker with Hours of Service

The TexVoIP Fleet Suite Hours of Service (HOS) solution automates your driver's logbook, helping to keep you in FMCSA compliance and minimize your financial risk.

TexVoIP Fleet Suite HOS Android application automates the FMCSA 395.15 rule-compliant driver vehicle inspector reports (DVIR) and is designed to comply with the ELD requirements keeping your drivers ready for inspectors anytime.

Avoid manual logging

Instead of having to manually complete detailed calculations for HOS compliance purposes, TexVoIP Fleet Suite HOS automatically logs the driver hours and calculates driver's available 'drive' time for them, reducing their workloads. And rather than a paper logbook, drivers use their Android device to view their available hours, manage their status or complete vehicle inspection reports.

Painless roadside inspections

For Roadside Inspections, the application provides the inspector all of the necessary information from the driver's HOS Log, while keeping personal information private. If a driver 'slip-seats' vehicles, their current log can easily be moved with them.

Always audit ready

Driver information is shared automatically with fleet managers, and managers can retrieve each driver's DOT Log on demand. They can review archived driver logs as required, and all of the electronic logs are easily accessible for any transportation authority in the event of an audit (MTO, DOT, etc.).

Better dispatching

With access to every driver's on-duty hours and availability, fleet manager dispatch decisions are easier to make, and fleet planning is simplified.

Driver Logging

- Near real-time display of current driver log
- View and change current driving status
- View total duty status report
- View available drive and long on-duty times
- Pop-up alerts for HOS rule violations
- Current and previous DVIR reports for each asset
- Select between authorized HOS Rules to accurately reflect the driver's Available Driving Hour Warnings

Vehicle Inspections

Assign (hook) or un-assign (drop) trailers at any time

- Pre-populated fault descriptions for inspection reports
- Digital sign-off of Driver Vehicle Inspection Report
- View current and previous DVIR reports for each asset
- Fleet-specific DVIR forms available for a small onetime fee

Asset Management

- Ability to "hook" or "drop" trailers, single or multiple
- Automatic logging of all asset hook or drop activity
- Perform DVIR inspections as unit are assigned

Fleet Management

- View near real-time HOS status of all drivers
- View individual driver logs:
 - o Available drive time, available cycle time, etc.
